### **Minutes**

#### 1. Presidents Annual Report

The club had a huge year of local, interclub, state and national level racing.

We started the year off with a couple of YCC crit races in Yamba followed by a road race series which took in our newly approved road courses. With Big River Way and James Creek added to our Woodford Island and Yamba Industrial Estate courses we now have a variety of roads to race on.

Club members raced the Grafton to Inverell, the Cunningham Classic (QLD), The Gravel and Granite (Tenterfield) the Devils Cardigan (Tasmania - Gravel National Champs) The Lismore Classic and a number of other significant races. We also had the inaugural running of the interclub series between Grafton CC, Byron Bay CC and the YCC, with 4 events held: a road race in Grafton, a crit in Byron and the final weekend being held here with riders participating in an ITT and a TTT.

I would like to thank all members of the 2022/23 committee for their efforts in helping the club to be a success.

#### 2. Committee Annual Reports

#### 2.1. Club Race Sub Committee

We had two new courses approved for racing: Big River Way and James Creek. These courses enable a different style of racing than the predominantly flat Woodford Island and the Yamba Crit Course.

The inaugural interclub series was a huge success with 50 riders participating across the three clubs (GCC, BBCC and YCC). We did have members take individual points honours, but unfortunately for our club, we did finish 3rd in the club championships.

#### 2.2. Grants Sub Committee

We were unsuccessful with a federal-level infrastructure grant to construct a purpose build cycle track to be used for criterium training and racing. An attempt will be made to consult with CVC to keep pushing ahead with our plans.
